

## Yearly Review 2015 - Tracker Outcomes

---

### Review of the year ending July 2015:

- A comparison between the outcomes for this year and last year show that we have made good progress in after school activity and maintained our high level of in school provision (see graphs below).
- We continue to provide **at least 2 hours of high quality PE every week for every child in the school**. This figure has remained consistent for many years and will continue to remain a high priority at Holy Trinity.
- Particularly pleasing are the higher percentages of children (38%) who have taken part in **inter-school competition** this year. This figure has more than **doubled from last year (17%)**. This is thanks to the increased provision of after school clubs which have led to an increase in inter school fixtures. Inter-school competition has been increased further by our regular involvement in the cross-country events this year.
- The total percentage of children attending an **after school club this year (72%)** is very close to the figure last year (73%). Continued efforts to raise this figure above 80% next year, by offering a wide variety of after school sports clubs, will remain a high priority.
- After school clubs are now **offered in more year groups than ever before**, and this year's figures show a more even spread of percentage uptake across the year groups. Note that Year 5 is a particularly "sporty" year so uptake is much higher for this class (93%).
- Leadership percentages are lower this year (6%) compared to last year (12%). This is due to the decision not to rotate our active play leaders; however, leadership opportunities have now been extended to Years 3 and 4. Leadership will be an on-going target for the coming year.
- We do not collect data on external clubs or community links. We have close links with Thanet Wanderers RFU, but this may be an area for future consideration.
