You might want to ask, were you scared of the thunder? When are you coming home? Do you miss your family? What do they look like? Do they look like the snail in the story?
Wednesday 17/06/20	Practise some of the sounds button words.	Watch 'The Snail and the Whale' (https://www.dailymotion.com/video/x5wvkfk) Discuss the word 'rhyme'. What is rhyme? Ask children to identify the rhyming words whilst they listen to the story. For example The big red hen, a pin on a map, I went to the beach with Mum and Dad.	Share the 'Slugs and Snails' PowerPoint . What do you know about snails? Can children identify what is the same and what is different about real / cartoon snails?
