Dominican Republic

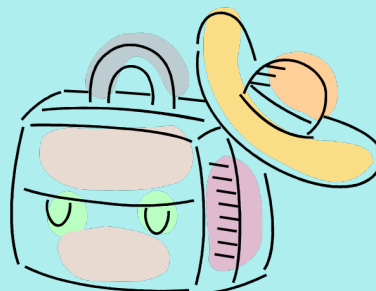

You will develop essential maths skills linked to ratio and proportion, calculating time differences, handling money, problem solving, percentages.

Most importantly, your learning is linked to the real world and you can use those skills when you go on holiday.

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This is a four week project.

Week 1

- learning to calculate time differences linked to world time
- research

Week 2

applying skills linked to data handling and science/geography (climate)

- creating graphs for rainfall, sunshine, temperature
- giving advice on what to pack
- exchange rates

Week 3

applying skills linked to ratio, percentages, calculator science

- calculating flight prices and discounts
- calculating travel distance
- calculating accommodation prices and discounts
- research into the islands habitats and adapted plants and animals

Week 4

applying skills linked to handling money, percentages, calculator, scaled drawings science

- using maps and calculating distances according to the map's scale
- research
- calculating excursions, meals out and discounts
- finish final travel brochure

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You will have to use the Internet a lot to find the relevant information.

. Make sure you have specific searches to narrow down the amount of websites.

. Do not rely too much on Wikipedia or the first website on the search engine's list. Is there a tourism board for the island?

. Be safe. If anything comes up on the screen you do not like, tell an adult.
