

Wednesday Activity: Read the text and **write down** the 9 features of a newspaper report (Wednesday English)

Keys to successful planning:

- 1) be imaginative, the information in your news report does not have to be true
- 2) write about the 5 W's: where, when, who, what and why the event happened
- 3) write a plan by thinking about the detail – be specific and descriptive
- 4) write interesting facts and reported speech from people involved in the event
- 5) have fun!
